SETTLEMENT HIERARCHY STUDY

APRIL 2015

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1. Introduction

- 1.1 The primary purpose of the Settlement Hierarchy Study is to assess the existing sustainability of the District's settlements and to rank them from the most to the least sustainable.
- 1.2 In doing so, the Study will examine a range of key factors that underpin the sustainability of a place to enable a reasoned and objective assessment to be reached.
- 1.3 Based on the findings of this Study, the Council will then be able to take into account the resulting settlement hierarchy when developing the Local Plan for Bolsover District.

2. Policy Context

National

2.1 The UK Government was the first government to produce a sustainable development strategy in response to the Rio Summit that took place 1992. This 1994 strategy was reviewed and led to the publication of the UK Sustainable Development Strategy: Securing the Future in March 2005.

2.2 The UK Sustainable Development Strategy: Securing the Future sets out five guiding principles of sustainable development, namely:

- Living Within Environmental Limits

Respecting the limits of the planet's environment, resources and biodiversity – to improve our environment and ensure that the natural resources needed for life are unimpaired and remain so for future generations.

- Ensuring a Strong, Healthy and Just Society

Meeting the diverse needs of all people in existing and future communities, promoting personal wellbeing, social cohesion and inclusion, and creating equal opportunity for all.

- Achieving a Sustainable Economy

Building a strong, stable and sustainable economy which provides prosperity and opportunities for all, and in which environmental and social costs fall on those who impose them (polluter pays), and efficient resource use is incentivised.

- Promoting Good Governance

Actively promoting effective, participative systems of governance in all levels of society – engaging people's creativity, energy, and diversity.

- Using Sound Science Responsibly

Ensuring policy is developed and implemented on the basis of strong scientific evidence, whilst taking into account scientific uncertainty (through the precautionary principle) as well as public attitudes and values.

2.3 The UK Sustainable Development Strategy is carried forward into the planning system through the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF). The NPPF stresses that the purpose of the planning system is to help achieve sustainable development and it advises that there are three dimensions to sustainable development: economic, social and environmental.

2.4 In light of these dimensions, the NPPF states that the planning system needs to perform the following three roles:

- an economic role – contributing to building a strong, responsive and competitive economy, by ensuring that sufficient land of the right type is available in the right places and at the right time to support growth and innovation; and by identifying and coordinating development requirements, including the provision of infrastructure;
- a social role – supporting strong, vibrant and healthy communities, by providing the supply of housing required to meet the needs of present and future generations; and by creating a high quality built environment, with accessible local services that reflect the community’s needs and support its health, social and cultural well-being; and
- an environmental role – contributing to protecting and enhancing our natural, built and historic environment; and, as part of this, helping to improve biodiversity, use natural resources prudently, minimise waste and pollution, and mitigate and adapt to climate change including moving to a low carbon economy.

2.5 The NPPF continues by stating that these roles should not be taken in isolation because they are mutually dependent. In particular, the NPPF includes the following points:

- planning should actively manage patterns of growth to make the fullest possible use of public transport, walking and cycling, and focus significant development in locations which are or can be made sustainable;
- authorities should recognise town centres as the heart of their communities and pursue policies to support their viability and vitality, defining a network and hierarchy of centres that is resilient to anticipated economic changes;
- plans and decisions should ensure developments that generate significant movement are located where the need to travel will be minimised and the use of sustainable transport modes will be maximised;
- key facilities such as primary schools and local shops should be located within walking distance of most properties.

2.6 This national policy overview identifies the key points that need to be taken into account when setting out a methodology to assess the existing sustainability of the District’s settlements.

Local

- 2.7 The Bolsover District Local Plan was adopted in February 2000 and so predates the UK Sustainable Development Strategy. However, it sets out the following aims directed at sustainability:
- 1) To encourage energy efficiency and influence the location and design of development to reduce energy wastage and encourage the use of energy efficient means of transport.
 - 2) To minimise pollution and reduce the extent to which current and future uses of land may be affected by pollution.
 - 3) To reduce consumption of non-renewable resources, including fossil fuels and land.
 - 4) To conserve and enhance biodiversity.
 - 5) To encourage the development and use of renewable resources.
 - 6) To restore, conserve and enhance local environmental quality.
- 2.8 Since the publication of the National Planning Policy Framework, the Council has also adopted the following criteria to assess the sustainability of proposed new sites for residential development:
- 1) access to public transport (within 400 metres walking distance of access to public transport services e.g. bus stop or railway station);
 - 2) proximity to schools (within 800 metres walking distance of a primary school, and 2000 metres walking distance of a secondary school);
 - 3) proximity to town / local centres (within 800 metres walking distance of a town centre or local centre);
 - 4) proximity to key employment sites or local jobs (within 2000 metres walking distance of a major employment site or area of employment i.e. over 100 jobs).
- 2.9 This local policy overview identifies the key points that also need to be taken into account when setting out a methodology to assess the existing sustainability of the District's settlements.

3. Methodology

Overview

- 3.1 In total 25 settlements were given settlement framework boundaries in the Bolsover District Local Plan (2000) (as shown in the table below). At the time these were considered to be the largest and the most sustainable settlements in the district.

- 3.2 Within the District there are also 28 other smaller hamlets and groupings of dwellings that have been identified within the Countryside, and are listed in the table below.

- 3.3 In 2000, the settlements in the countryside had low amounts of dwellings and few services, if any. However, all settlements were re-considered to determine which

settlements in principle have a minimum level of sustainability that should be further assessed in the study. The following standard¹ was used -

A settlement should meet three of the four following criteria to be included in the study:

- Be compact (i.e. not comprised of fragmented, disparate blocks of development and mainly consist of a continuous form of development);
- Have a population of 500 or more;
- Have a community facility such as a primary school or a community centre (including a Public House, Miner's Welfare or similar that could be used for a community gathering);
- Have public transport providing access to a larger settlement with at least 1 service in each of the 2 peak periods (8am-10am and 4pm to 6pm Monday to Saturday).

3.4 All settlements were assessed against this standard and the results are shown in Appendix 2. All of the settlements in the countryside failed to meet the standard. Bentinck is the only settlement with a settlement framework in the adopted local plan that fails to meet the above standard. The settlements in the countryside and Bentinck have therefore been excluded from the study.

3.5 Based on the policy context outlined in Section 2, it is considered that the following sustainability factors need to be taken into account when setting out a methodology to assess the existing sustainability of the District's settlements that meet the standard for a minimum level of sustainability:

- the number of people already living in a settlement;
- the availability of employment opportunities in a settlement;
- the provision of shops, services and other community facilities in recognised town or local centres or elsewhere within a settlement;
- the availability of public transport services from a settlement.

3.6 The approach and weighting given to each of these sustainability factors is explained more fully below. Data has been collected for each of the above sustainability factors, for the District's 24 settlements that meet the above standard.

Population

3.7 Whilst the population of a settlement in some ways can seem an arbitrary measure of sustainability, scoring settlements by the size of their population does take account of where larger quantities of people live and as a result where larger numbers of people start their journey to work, shops, services and facilities from.

¹ This standard is based on a similar standard used in the Settlement Hierarchy Study (2011). This document provided evidence for the Local Plan Strategy which was withdrawn in 2013 along with all of its supporting evidence documents.

- 3.8 Due to the way the market works and the way public services are planned, the larger settlements often have more of the journey destinations as well, such as shops and services. So, whilst this is actually assessed separately, the larger a settlement's population the greater the likelihood that journeys both start and finish within the same settlement.
- 3.9 In addition, the larger a settlement's population the greater the likelihood that its population will sustain those shops and services and potentially support new ones.
- 3.10 Finally, by using population as an indicator it is also possible to see how a settlement's population score compares with its services and facilities score, so informing decisions about future growth.
- 3.11 Based on this approach, the settlement with the largest population has had its population divided into deciles and each settlement is given the score relating to which decile its population falls within (see table 2 below).

- 3.12 The weighting given to the population level score is 25% of the settlement's total sustainability ranking.

Employment

- 3.13 The availability of employment opportunities in a settlement is a common factor when assessing a settlement's sustainability ranking, recognising that jobs are a major journey generator and that if these are located close to where people live there is a greater chance people can use more sustainable modes of transport to get to work.
- 3.14 This approach also reflects the economic role outlined in the NPPF and as implemented locally when assessing proposals for new residential developments on their walking distance from key employment sites or local jobs.

- 3.15 Based on this approach, the settlement with the largest number of jobs has had its number of jobs divided into deciles and each settlement is given the score relating to which decile its number of jobs falls within (see table 4 below).

- 3.17 The weighting given to the employment level score is 25% of the settlement's total sustainability ranking.

Services / Facilities

- 3.18 The provision of shops, services and other community facilities within a settlement is a common factor when assessing a settlement's sustainability ranking, recognising that shops and facilities such as schools and doctors surgeries are also major journey generators and that if these are located close to where people live there is a greater chance people can use more sustainable modes of transport to get to them.
- 3.19 This approach reflects the emphasis within the NPPF that authorities should recognise town centres as the heart of their communities and as implemented locally when assessing proposals for new residential developments on their walking distance from shops or schools.
- 3.20 For information, the list of facilities and individual points for these facilities is as follows:

- 5 points Primary, Junior or Infants School; Secondary School; Doctor's Surgery; Pharmacy; Post Office; Leisure Centre or a Community Centre / Village Hall
- 3 points Dentist; Library; Day Nursery / Pre-School; Recreation Ground / Sports Pitch or Equipped Play Areas
- 3 up to 7 points Convenience Food Store or General Stores Shop (depending on size)
- 1 point Other Shops; Cafes / Restaurants, Hot Food

Takeaways, Pubs or Clubs; Places of Worship;
other businesses and services that provide a service
to the local community

- 3.21 In establishing this points system, it is noted that a judgement needs to be made on the relative importance of these facilities. However, given the purpose of this Study is to assess the existing sustainability of the District's settlements, more points have been awarded to those services and facilities that it is judged a community need to use more regularly. As a result, if a settlement offers that facility, so meaning that people living there would not need to travel elsewhere to access that facility, its overall sustainability score benefits.
- 3.22 It should be noted that whilst all of these facilities are beneficial, the Council considers that settlements do not need to have all of the facilities to be considered a sustainable settlement. This said, the more facilities the settlement has, the more sustainable it can be considered to be.
- 3.23 Finally, it should also be noted that the study does not look at the quality of services and facilities, their levels of usage or the relative ease of access to them by different modes of transport.
- 3.24 Based on this approach, the settlement with the largest number of services and facilities within or adjacent to its settlement framework has had its number of services and facilities divided into deciles and each settlement is given the score relating to which decile its number of services and facilities falls within (see table 5 below).

- 3.25 The weighting given to the services and facilities level score is 25% of the settlement's total sustainability ranking.

Public Transport Services

- 3.26 The availability of public transport services from a settlement is a common factor when assessing a settlement's sustainability ranking, recognising that buses and trains offer

mass transportation systems so reducing the consumption of resources per journey per person as well as helping reduce congestion.

- 3.27 This also reflects the emphasis within the NPPF that authorities should actively manage patterns of growth to make the fullest possible use of public transport, walking and cycling and as implemented locally when assessing proposals for new residential developments on their walking distance from bus stops or railway stations.
- 3.28 Based on this approach, the settlement with the highest score for its public transport services has had its score divided into deciles and each settlement is given the score relating to which decile its score falls within (see table 6 below).
- 3.29 For information, bus and rail services were scored on their frequency on Mondays to Saturdays on the following basis:
- More than 1 bus per hour – 5 points
 - 1 bus per hour – 4 points
 - 1 bus every two hours – 3 points
 - Less than 9 buses a day – 2 points
 - Less than 4 buses a day – 1 point
 - None – 0 points

- 3.30 The weighting given to the public transport facilities level score is 25% of the settlement's total sustainability ranking.

4. **Findings**

Population

- 4.1 As set out in Section 3, population has been identified as a key sustainability factor. The following section outlines what data has been used and also the findings of the Study.

Data Source

- 4.2 Population data is available both from primary sources, such as Census counts, and from secondary statistic modelling that draws upon Census data and household data.
- 4.3 The 2011 Census records the population of Bolsover District as 75,900 on the 27th March 2011. The data set recorded by this snapshot provides a primary source when looking to identify the population for individual settlements, but as the Census records data in Output Areas which do not always align with settlement boundaries, it is not always easily translatable. It is also now over four years old and therefore becoming slightly out of date.
- 4.4 To overcome these difficulties, secondary statistical modelling is often used drawing upon other data sources. In preparing its population information, the Council has drawn upon Council Tax property records from April 2011 to obtain both the number of properties in a settlement, as defined by the Bolsover District Local Plan settlement frameworks, and the occupancy rate for the settlement.
- 4.5 As can be seen in the table in Appendix 1, the number of properties has been multiplied by the estimated household size for each Parish provided by the 2011 Census data to obtain population figures for each settlement. The sum of these figures has been cross-checked against the Census 75,900 figure and was found to have a very small margin of divergence (0.64%). Based on the strength of this extremely close alignment, the population figures for each settlement have been adjusted slightly to correct this minor divergence.
- 4.6 To update this 2011 data, the number of housing completions in each settlement between 2011 and 2014, as adjusted by the appropriate occupancy rate, has been added to the 2011 number of houses. This new total has been multiplied by the estimated household size for each Parish provided by the 2011 Census data to obtain updated population figures for each settlement.
- 4.7 The full population calculations are set out in Appendix 1 but the 2014 estimated population figures for the District and individual settlements are set out in Table 7 overleaf.

Findings

- 4.8 As per the methodology set out in Section 3, the population for Bolsover, as the largest settlement, is divided into deciles and each settlement is given the score relating to which decile its population falls within.

4.9 The findings of this are set out in table 8 below.

Employment

4.10 As set out in Section 3, the availability of employment opportunities has been identified as a key sustainability factor. The following section outlines what data has been used and also the findings of the Study.

Data Source

- 4.11 Employment data is available from a range of sources but NOMIS provide the most up-to-date data via the Business Register Employment Survey (BRES).
- 4.12 The 2013 BRES records the number of full time and part-time employees within Bolsover District as 30,160. The data set recorded by this snapshot provides information by ward which is rounded up or down to the nearest hundred. As a result, the information does not easily correspond to settlement framework boundaries.
- 4.13 In view of this, the information has needed to be allocated to settlements based on a judgement of known employment areas and utilising the Bolsover District Local Plan’s settlement framework boundaries. This situation will involve some jobs in countryside locations being attributed to the settlement or settlements in the same ward but it is considered that the number of instances in which this occurs is limited.
- 4.14 Furthermore, due to the restrictions on how the BRES data is publicised in order to protect individual company’s data, the data for the District’s smaller settlements, where it would be potentially possible to identify the number of employees at an individual company, has been published in this Study as being within a range.

- 4.15 The information provided by the 2013 BRES for the District's settlements is set out in Table 9 below. Where judgements have been made, a note has been provided.

Findings

- 4.16 As per the methodology set out in Section 3, the job figure for South Normanton, as the settlement with the largest number of jobs, is divided into deciles and each settlement is given the score relating to which decile its population falls within.
- 4.17 The findings of this are set out in table 10 below.

Services and facilities

- 4.18 As set out in Section 3, the provision of shops, services and other community facilities has been identified as a key sustainability factor. The following section outlines what data has been used and also the findings of the Study.

Data Source

- 4.19 Data on the provision of shops, services and other community facilities has been collected via surveys of each of the settlements during March 2015.
- 4.20 The information provided by the 2015 surveys for the District's settlements is set out in Table 11 below. Further detail is provided in Appendix 2.

- 4.21 For information, the District's edge-of-centre and out-of-town retail centres have been allocated to the settlement that they are most closely associated with.
- 4.22 This has seen the Mansfield Designer Outlet Centre, which is principally a regional shopping centre, being allocated to South Normanton on the basis that it is within the settlement framework covering South Normanton, Pinxton and the Castlewood Employment Area and is most closely associated with South Normanton given its proximity to the Ball Hill area of South Normanton.
- 4.23 On a similar basis, the comparison goods shops that are part of the Dobbies complex at Barlborough have been allocated to Barlborough.
- 4.24 Despite this, the influence of these decisions is relatively minimal given the approach taken to awarding settlements points as set out in table 12.

Findings

- 4.25 As per the methodology set out in Section 3, the services and facilities points total for Shirebrook, as the settlement with the highest points total, is divided into deciles and each settlement is given the score relating to which decile its points total falls within.
- 4.26 The findings of this are set out in table 12 below.

Public Transport Services

4.27 As set out in Section 3, the availability of public transport services from a settlement has been identified as a key sustainability factor. The following section outlines what data has been used and also the findings of the Study.

Data Source

4.28 Data on the availability of public transport services has been collected from analysis of bus and train timetables during March 2015. This is set out in detail in Appendix 4.

4.29 A summary of the information provided by the 2015 analysis for the District's settlements is set out in Table 13 below.

Findings

- 4.30 As per the methodology set out in Section 3, the public transport points total for Shirebrook, as the settlement with the highest points total, is divided into deciles and each settlement is given the score relating to which decile its points total falls within.
- 4.31 The findings of this are set out in table 14 below.

- 4.32 The findings show that generally speaking the more populated settlements have higher scores for public transport services. The exceptions to this are Langwith and Pleasley which have smaller populations but which benefit from being on main bus routes due to their geographical locations.
- 4.33 Shirebrook, Whaley Thorns, Creswell and Whitwell have a train station on the Robin Hood Line. This train service contributes 8 points to each of their scores in table 13.

5. Conclusions

Summary of Findings

- 5.1 Based on the findings outlined in Section 4, a hierarchy of the relative sustainability of the District's settlements can be made by adding up the scores for the four key sustainability factors. This settlement hierarchy is outlined in table 15 below.

- 5.2 What this settlement hierarchy shows is that based on the methodology selected, South Normanton and Shirebrook are the District's most sustainable settlements, with 37 and 36 out of 40 respectively.

- 5.3 Below these two settlements is the District's largest settlement, Bolsover, which despite achieving maximum scores for both population and facilities and services only achieves 30 out of 40 due to its low employment score.
- 5.4 After these relatively more sustainable settlements comes Clowne with 23 out of 40 and then Barlborough, Pinxton, Creswell and Tibshelf with scores between 20 and 17 out of 40.
- 5.5 Of the remaining settlements, only Langwith, Whitwell, Blackwell, Newton, Whaley Thorns and Pleasley score 10 or more out of 40.
- 5.6 With scores below 10 out of 40, Glapwell, Westhouses, New Houghton, Shuttlewood, Doe Lea / Bramley Vale, Scarcliffe, Hodthorpe, Palterton and Stanfree are among the District's least sustainable settlements. Finally, Hilcote scores the lowest possible score of 4 out of 40 and can be considered the District's least sustainable settlement.

Implications

- 5.7 The evidence provided by this Settlement Hierarchy Study will be an important consideration when the Council develops the Local Plan for Bolsover District and will provide a benchmark when considering development proposals.
- 5.8 However, it should be noted that the position of the settlement within the hierarchy does not inevitably mean that the Council will direct growth to that settlement as other factors, such as environmental and deliverability constraints, which are not considered within this Study will need to be taken into account. It is also quite possible that through a planned approach a lower scoring settlement could become more sustainable if growth also generated more services, community facilities, employment opportunities and potentially better public transport services.
- 5.9 Finally, it is also noted that the data upon which the hierarchy is based reflects the position at a point in time. As a result, the Council will monitor the availability of relevant data sources and will update the Settlement Hierarchy Study should this prove necessary.
