The Annual Governance Statement will be agreed by the Council's Audit Committee on 15 May 2018.

The Council's accounts are subject to external audit by Mr T Crawley, for and on behalf of KPMG LLP, St Nicholas House, 31 Park Row, Nottingham, NG1 6FQ.

1. From 1 June 2018 to 12 July 2018 between 9 am and 4 pm any person may inspect the accounts of the Council for the year ended 31 March 2018 and certain related documents (comprising books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts) at the address given below. They may also make copies of the accounts and documents.
2. From 9 am on 1 June 2018 to 4 pm on 12 July 2018 at the request of a local government elector, the local auditor must give the elector, or any representative of the elector, an opportunity to question the auditor about the accounting records of the Council.
3. From 9 am on 1 June 2018 to 4pm on 12 July 2018 a local government elector for the area of the Council, or his/her representative, may object to the Council's accounts asking that the auditor issue a report in the public interest and/or apply for a declaration that an item in the accounts is contrary to law (under section 28 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014). Written notice of the proposed objection and the grounds on which it is made must be sent to the auditor at the address given above and copied to me at the address given below.
