Please ensure when you employ a waste collection company they are a registered waste carrier so you comply with the Household Waste Duty of Care Regulations 2005.

Refuse Collection

Please help us to help you

- Ensure wheelie bins are **presented** at the kerbside or an agreed collection point on the day of collection by **no later than 6.00am**.
- Please ensure the **lid is closed** (flat lid)
- **SIDE WASTE IS NOT TAKEN AT ANY TIME with your black or green bins.**
- Please don't overload your bin.
- Large card packaging may be presented with **burgundy bins**.
- Recycle as much of your waste as possible, using your **burgundy bin**.
- Household bulky waste can be disposed of free of charge at the Household Waste Recycling Centres at Stonegravels, Sheffield Road, Chesterfield, S41 7LF and also at Buttermilk Lane, S44 6AF (between Long Duckmanton & Bolsover). Opening hours 8.30am - 6pm daily.
- We provide a bulk collection service. A small charge is made. Please call 01246 242424.

What can I put in my green bin?

Yes please:

- ✓ Grass cuttings, flowers and weeds
- ✓ Leaves, hedge and plant clippings, prunings
- ✓ Left over fruit, salad, vegetable waste, egg shells
- ✓ Cooked food leftovers - bread, pastries, pasta, meat fish (raw and cooked - including bones) plate scrapings, tea bags and coffee grounds

Food can be placed in biodegradable food bags manufactured to the British Standard EN13432 only. (No retail carrier bags)

During green bin suspension weeks, please place food waste in your black bin.

No thanks:

- ✗ Cardboard boxes and card packaging - these go in your **burgundy bin** (see overleaf)
- ✗ Wallpaper and wrapping paper
- ✗ Waxed packaging - such as juice cartons. These go in your **burgundy bin**
- ✗ Stone, rubble, soil or turf
- ✗ Dog and cat waste
- ✗ Disposable nappies
- ✗ Plastic (see list) these go in your **burgundy bin**
- ✗ All TYPES of bin liners, carrier bags, packaging, foil or polystyrene
- ✗ Bottles, cans & papers - these go in your **burgundy bin**
- ✗ Timber or plywood
- ✗ Ashes

Please do not contaminate your green bin with unsuitable waste as we will be unable to collect it.

Your Burgundy bin collections

Over the Christmas/Winter period the burgundy bins will continue to be emptied fortnightly but you may receive a collection on a black bin week or suspended green bin week. Collections will be made:

Commencing: 4th December 2018 (Burgundy bin only)

Commencing: 18th December 2018 (Burgundy & Black bins).

Collections will then continue every fortnight the same week as your green bin/suspended green bin collections.

What goes in the burgundy bin?

- ✓ Mixed plastics (i.e. bottles, food trays, yogurt & margarine tubs)
- ✓ Empty food tins and drink cans
- ✓ Glass bottles and jars
- ✓ Flattened cardboard
- ✓ Empty aerosols
- ✓ Textiles & Shoes (in a clear plastic bag)
- ✓ Brown paper envelopes
- ✓ Foil & foil food trays (washed & squashed)
- ✓ Waxed food packaging (i.e. milk, fruit juice containers)

Inner box or bag:

- ✓ Newspapers
- ✓ Magazines
- ✓ Paper
- ✓ Telephone directories
- ✓ Catalogues
- ✓ Junk mail
- ✓ Glossy pamphlets
- ✓ White envelopes
- ✓ Shredded paper (weighted down in bottom by other papers)
- ✓ Small household batteries (in a clear plastic bag, tied to the bin handle)

If you have been supplied with a bag for recycling paper, place this either on top of the bin lid or at the side of the bin. Please don't place it inside the bin as there is a risk it could be tipped in the back of the vehicle.

Extra recycling that won't fit in your burgundy bin, can be presented in a box/clear bag at the side of the burgundy bin on collection day. Large flattened cardboard packaging may also be put at the side of your burgundy bin.

Please do not place recycling in any plastic bag(s) in your burgundy bin.

No thanks:

- ✗ Plastic/Carrier bags, unless used to contain textiles. Please do not use carrier bags to dispose of any other recyclable materials ie. cans/bottles
- ✗ Windowpanes, cookware, pyrex, windscreens
- ✗ Crisp packets, plastic wrappings (eg. film, cellophane, polythene and bubble wrap)
- ✗ Household waste - such as nappies, food waste, dog waste
- ✗ Wrapping paper & greetings cards
- ✗ Polystyrene
