Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulation 5 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 that the following exempt report is intended to be considered in private at the above Meeting of Cabinet. This was not included the List Of Key Decisions And Items To Be Considered In Private which was issued on 18th January 2019.

Restructure of the Contentious Legal Team

To consider a recommendation to restructure the Contentious Legal Team by making a temporary 0.6FTE permanent and to recommend a revenue budget increase to accommodate the changes.

Compliance with the requirement to give 28 clear days notice in accordance with the above Regulation is impracticable as the matter is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred.

Reason for urgency: Decision needs to be approved by the end of the financial year
