Comments:

There are no changes to the Whitwell Ward. Other than new polling district references, no changes are proposed to the existing polling districts or polling places.

The ward comprises Whitwell Parish and the boundaries of the Parish and District ward are coterminous.

There are two polling stations at Whitwell Community Centre.

The proposed polling places for these polling districts are considered to provide reasonable and convenient facilities for electors.

Comments:

This new ward comprises Barlborough Parish Council and the North Ward of Clowne Parish Council.

Part of the former polling district CB1 has been transferred into the Barlborough Ward from Clowne. It comprises the new Clowne Parish (North Ward) and the area is required by law to be a separate polling district.

Electors in existing polling district CB1 (part 1) currently vote at the Clowne Community Centre which is now outside the polling district and electoral ward. The ARO has not been able to identify a suitable polling place within the new polling district or electoral ward and for the reasons set out below is recommending that electors in the new polling district BRB2 should vote at "The Arc", Bolsover District Council Offices which is considered suitable and convenient for electors.

The ARO considers that introducing additional electors and electoral areas into the polling place located at Clowne Community Centre creates an unacceptable level of risk and does not consider this to be any more convenient for electors within the new polling district than the proposed polling place. Allocating Clowne Community Centre as the polling place for the new polling district is not considered to be suitable; the size and complexity of the allocated electorate and electoral arrangement would be more than could feasibly be accommodated at the location. In order to mitigate these issues and having regard to the Electoral Commission's guidance the Council is, therefore, recommended to designate "The Arc" as the new polling place for electors in polling district BRB2.

Under the proposals as now submitted Clowne Community Centre would continue to be the polling place for electors from Clowne East District and Parish Wards (4515 electors as at 1st February 2018 allocated to 3 polling stations).

Barlborough Ward previously comprised two polling districts (AA1 and AB1) and electors in these polling districts vote at the same polling place and in the same District, Parish and County elections. It is proposed that the existing polling districts be merged to provide a new polling district BRB1 and that electors continue to vote at the same polling place, which is suitable and convenient.

Comments:

These two part existing polling districts comprise the new Clowne East ward and the District and Parish ward boundaries are coterminous.

Electors in existing polling districts CB1 (part 2) and CC1 (part 2) now comprise the new Clowne East Ward. These polling districts are in the same District and Parish Ward and County Division and it is recommended that they be merged to form a new polling district CLE1.

Electors in the new polling district currently vote at the Clowne Community Centre which is located within the new polling district CLE1 and it is proposed that they continue to do so. The ARO intends to allocate these electors to 3 polling stations at the Community Centre.

The proposed polling place is considered to provide reasonable and convenient facilities for electors.

Comments:

This new ward comprises the new "Old Bolsover with Stanfree" Parish ward and Clowne Parish west ward.

The new polling district CLW1 comprises the new Clowne Parish west ward. Electors in this polling district currently vote at the Clowne Community Centre which is now outside of the polling district and electoral ward.

The Arc, Bolsover District Council Offices, has been identified as an alternative polling place. It is both situated within the polling district and suitable and convenient for electors in polling district CLW1. The ARO does not consider that there are special circumstances evident that would suggest a need for the polling place to be located outside of the polling district.

The ARO considers that introducing additional electors and electoral areas into the polling place located at Clowne Community Centre creates an unacceptable level of risk and does not consider this to be any more convenient for electors within the new polling district than the proposed polling place. Allocating Clowne Community Centre as the polling place for the new polling district is not considered to be suitable; the size and complexity of the allocated electorate and electoral arrangement would be more than could feasibly be

accommodated at the location. In order to mitigate these issues and having regard to the Electoral Commission's guidance the Council is, therefore, recommended to designate "The Arc" as the new polling place for electors in polling district CLW1.

Electors in existing polling districts BC1 (part 1) and BC2 together now comprise the Old Bolsover with Stanfree Parish ward and it is proposed that the existing polling districts be merged to form one polling district CLW2 for the new parish ward.

It is proposed that all electors in the newly merged polling district CLW2 would vote at Oxcroft Miners Welfare, which is located within the new polling district and is suitable and convenient for electors. Electors in BC1 (part) currently vote at the Oxcroft Miners Welfare. Electors in the existing polling district BC2 currently vote at the Brockley Primary School which is outside the polling district and the new Clowne West ward boundary.

Comments:

This new ward comprises the new “Old Bolsover Central” Parish Ward and the new “Old Bolsover North with Shuttlewood” Parish Ward.

It is proposed that existing polling districts BC1 (part 2) and BB1 be merged to form a new polling district BNS1. Both polling districts are in the same District and Parish wards and County division. It is further proposed that electors in the new polling district BNS1 should vote at Brockley Primary School which is located within the new polling district and is suitable and convenient for electors. Electors in existing polling district BB1 currently vote at Brockley Primary School. Electors in existing polling district BC1 (part 2) currently vote at the Oxcroft Miners Welfare which is outside the polling district and the new ward boundary.

It is proposed that existing polling districts BD1 and BE1 be merged to form a new polling district BNS2. Both Polling districts are in the same District and Parish wards and County division and the electors currently vote at the same polling place, the Assembly Hall. It is suggested that the continued use of the Assembly Hall provides the most reasonable and convenient facility for electors in polling district BNS2. The polling place is, however, located just outside both the polling district and electoral ward. The ARO is satisfied that there are special circumstances to justify the use of a polling place outside of the polling district, given that it is the current polling place for all electors within the polling district, its proximity to the polling district boundary and a lack of appropriate alternative location. For the convenience of electors the Council is, therefore, recommended to approve the continued use of this polling place.

Electors in BJ2 (part) comprise the new "Old Bolsover Central" parish ward. These electors currently vote at Bolsover Parish Rooms, Hornscroft Road which is within the polling district and it is proposed that they continue to do so.

Comments:

This new ward is coterminous with the new "Old Bolsover East" Parish Ward.

It is proposed that existing polling districts BF1 and BJ2 (part 2) which comprises electors in the Portland Avenue, Smithson Avenue, Portland Crescent and Cavendish Road area be merged to form a new polling district, BOE1. Both Polling districts are in the same District and Parish wards and County division.

It is further proposed that electors in the new polling district BOE1 should vote at the Assembly Hall which is located within the new polling district, is suitable and convenient for electors and is currently the polling place for electors in existing polling district BF1. Electors in BJ2 (part 2) currently vote at the Bolsover Parish Rooms which is outside the new polling district and electoral ward.

Electors in the new polling district BOE2 (Whaley Village and Whaley Common) currently vote at a Mobile Station on Whaley Common. The ARO endeavoured to identify a suitable alternative polling place within the Whaley Village, however, a possible building at Whaley Farm required a number of adaptations and it was considered that the current arrangements would be more suitable for electors.

Comments:

This new ward comprises the new "Old Bolsover south" Parish ward and the new Scarcliffe North Parish Ward of Scarcliffe Parish Council. Two polling stations are located at Bainbridge Hall.

It is proposed that existing polling districts BJ1 and BJ2 (part) be merged to form a new polling district BOS1. Both Polling districts are in the same District and Parish wards and County division. Electors in existing polling district BJ1 currently vote at Bainbridge Hall and it is proposed that they continue to do so along with the 18 electors from BJ2 (part) which together now form the new polling district BOS1.

It is further proposed that existing polling districts FD1 (part) and FB1 part (largely rural areas of Scarcliffe Parish) be merged with existing polling district FC1. These polling districts together comprise Scarcliffe Parish North ward and are in the same District ward and County division. Electors in existing polling district FC1 currently vote at the Hillstown Village Hall and it is proposed that they continue to do so along with the 2 electors from the other part polling districts which form the new polling district BOS2.

The proposed polling places for these polling districts are considered to provide suitable and convenient facilities for electors.

Comments:

This new ward comprises the existing parishes of Pleasley, Glapwell, Ault Hucknall and the new Scarcliffe South ward of Scarcliffe Parish.

The new Scarcliffe South ward comprises existing polling districts FB1 (part 2) (Scarcliffe Village) and FD1 (part 2) (Palterton Village). It is proposed to retain these part polling districts but change the polling district references. Electors in these areas will continue to vote at their existing polling places.

Electors in existing polling districts KC1 and KF1 are in the same District and Parish wards and County division and it is proposed to merge the polling districts to form one new polling district for this area. Electors in these areas will continue to vote at their existing polling places.

In respect of the remainder of the ward, other than new polling district references, no changes are proposed to the existing polling districts or polling places.

The proposed polling places for these polling districts are considered to provide suitable and convenient facilities for electors

Comments:

This new ward comprises the parish of Langwith (Bathurst ward, Bassett ward and Poulter ward) and the new Shirebrook and Langwith ward of Shirebrook Parish.

Existing polling district GD1 (part 1) comprises the new Shirebrook Parish (Shirebrook and Langwith Ward) and the law requires that it must remain a separate polling district.

Electors in GD1 (part 1) currently vote at Shirebrook Village Hall and it is recommended that the continued use of Shirebrook Village Hall provides a reasonable and convenient facility for electors in this polling district. The polling place is, however, located outside both the polling district and the electoral ward. The ARO is satisfied that there are special circumstances to justify the use of a polling place

outside of the polling district, given that it is the current polling place for all electors within the polling district, its proximity to the polling district boundary and a lack of appropriate alternative location. For the convenience of electors the Council is, therefore, recommended to approve the continued use of this polling place.

Existing polling districts FP1 and FM1 together comprise the Poulter ward of Langwith Parish and are in the same District ward and County division. It is proposed that these polling districts be merged to form the new polling district LNG3 and continue to vote at Langwith Junction Bowls Club, although there are some concerns with the current polling station arrangements.

The polling station at Langwith Junction Bowls Club is located in the kitchen and whilst reasonable and practicable adaptations are carried out, the narrow pathway restricts manoeuvrability for some wheelchair users and Presiding Officers have complained of smoke in the polling station as a result of the location of an outdoor smoking shelter near to the station. Following discussions with the Club, it would be possible to site a mobile polling station in the car park which would be more suitable and convenient for electors.

The Council is, therefore, recommended to approve provision of a mobile polling station at Langwith Junction Bowls Club.

In respect of the remainder of the ward, other than new polling district references, no changes are proposed to the existing polling districts or polling places.

Comments:

This new ward is coterminous with the new parish ward of Shirebrook North.

There are two polling stations at Shirebrook Village Hall.

Electors in existing polling Districts GD1 (part 2) and GC1 currently vote at Shirebrook Village Hall and it is proposed that they continue to do so. However, now that these polling districts are in the same District and Parish ward and County division, it is further proposed that

the polling districts be merged.

Electors in existing polling district GB1 (part 1) currently vote at Shirebrook Methodist Church which is outside the new ward boundary. It is proposed that Carter Lane Community Centre which is within the ward and polling district would provide a suitable and convenient polling place for these electors. Electors in existing polling district GJ1 (part 1) currently vote at the Carter Lane Community Centre and would continue to do so.

It is further proposed to merge the 2 existing polling districts (GB1 part 1 and GJ1 part 1) to form a new polling district SHN1, by amending the polling district boundary between the new polling districts SHN1 and SHN2.

The amendment proposes that the southern boundary between the new polling districts SHN1 and SHN2 be along Carter Lane, meaning that the properties to the south of Carter Lane would be included in polling district SHN1. It is suggested that it would be more convenient for electors in The Rocklands, Summit Drive, Hilltop Avenue, Mayflower Court and Rockley Way to vote at Carter Lane Community Centre than their current polling place, Shirebrook Village Hall. This proposal would affect 187 electors.

This new ward is coterminous with the parish ward of Shirebrook South

Electors in Polling District GJ1 (part 2), namely properties south on Main Street, off and around Stinting Lane, currently vote at Carter Lane Community Centre which is now in the Shirebrook North Ward. It is proposed that these electors vote at Shirebrook Methodist Church, which is considered suitable and convenient for the electors and is located within the Shirebrook South Ward.

In so doing, it is proposed that the polling district boundary between the existing polling district GJ1 (part 2) and GF1 be amended so that the electors in the Newbarn Close, Leen Valley Drive (part), Teal Close, Station View, Mallard Close area are included with the adjoining properties in GJ1 (part 2) and together form the new polling district SHS3, voting at Shirebrook Methodist Church. It is considered that this will provide a clearer, more defined polling district boundary and that Shirebrook Methodist Church should be more convenient for electors than their current polling place, the Victoria Inn. This proposal would affect 471 electors.

Other than new polling district references, no other changes are proposed in this ward.

There are 3 polling stations at Pinxton Village Hall.

Other than new polling district references, no changes are proposed to the existing polling districts or polling places.

The proposed polling place for these polling districts is considered to provide suitable and convenient facilities for electors.
